The following programmes will be offered in the evening from 5.30 p.m. to 8.30 p.m. on **weekdays** at the main Campus, off Langata Road from **6th January 2010**. Transport is available from **KICC Grounds, Westlands through Lavington, Community Area along Ngong Road via Karen shopping centre, and Nyayo Stadium from 4.30 p.m.** at a fee of **Ksh. 4,000** per trimester (optional).

POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

2. Master of Science with specialization in the following areas:

1. Applied Mathematics;
2. Pure Mathematics;
3. Statistics.

Minimum entry requirements

Holders of a Bachelor of Science in Mathematics or Bachelor of Education (Double Mathematics) with a Second Class Honours (Upper Division) or the equivalent from a recognized institution.

3. Master of Education (2 years) with specialization in any of the following areas:

1. Educational Administration and Planning
2. Educational Research and Evaluation
3. Curriculum Studies

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

An Upper Second Class Honours Degree of The Catholic University of Eastern Africa or its equivalent from a recognised institution and in an appropriate discipline. In exceptional circumstances, a holder of Lower Second Class Honours degree with at least two years teaching experience may be admitted to the M.Ed Programme.

4. Master of Business Administration (Both Full-time and Evening Programmes) with specialization in the following areas: *(To be offered in August 2010)*

1. Strategic Management;
2. Financial Management;
3. Marketing and Management;
4. Human Resource Management;
5. Electronic Commerce;
6. Entrepreneurship;

5. Postgraduate Diploma in Planning and Management of Development Projects.

Minimum entry requirements

A Bachelor's Degree from a recognized institution.

BACHELORS PROGRAMMES

1. Bachelor of Science in Computer Science

Minimum entry requirements

2-year programme

A **Higher National Diploma in Computer Science** from Kenya National Examinations Council or the equivalent.

3-year programme

- A relevant diploma (minimum two year duration) with a mean grade of C plain in Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination or the equivalent, and at least a C plain in Mathematics, **OR**
- At **least two principal passes**, one of which must be in either Mathematics or Physics in the KACE, EAACE, or GCE A-level or their equivalent **OR**
- **IMIS Higher Diploma** with mean grade of C plain in Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination and a C plain in Mathematics or the equivalent.

4-year programme

- Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination with at least a mean grade of C+ or the equivalent, and at least a C plain in Mathematics

2. Bachelor of Science with specialization in any of the following areas: Biology, Chemistry, or Physics

Minimum entry requirements

4-year programme

- Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination with at least a mean grade of C+ or the equivalent, and at least a C plain in subjects related to the course applied for. Applicants for Chemistry and Physics must also have a minimum of Grade C plain in Mathematics.

3-year programme

- A relevant diploma (minimum two year duration) with a mean grade of grade C plain in Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination or the equivalent. Applicants for Chemistry and Physics must also have a minimum of Grade C plain in Mathematics, **OR**
- At **least two principal passes**, one of which must be in either Biology, Physics or Chemistry in the KACE, EAACE, or GCE A-level or their equivalent.

2-year programme

- A relevant **Higher National Diploma** from Kenya National Examinations Council or the equivalent.

3. Bachelor of Arts in Social Sciences with specialization in any of the following areas: Economics, Sociology, Anthropology, Political Science, or Social Work.

Minimum entry requirements

2-year programme (Social Work)

A Higher National Diploma from Kenya National Examinations Council in social work or the equivalent.

3-year programme

- Two principal passes in the KACE, EAACE or GCE A-level in any arts subject, **OR**
- A two year Diploma with a mean grade of C plain in Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination or the equivalent.

4-year programme

- Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination with at least a mean grade of C+ or the equivalent **OR**
- A one year Diploma in a relevant area from a recognized institution, with at least a mean grade of C plain in the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination or the equivalent.

4. BACHELOR OF COMMERCE with specialization in any of the following areas:

• <i>Accounting</i>	• <i>Human Resources Management</i>
• <i>Finance</i>	• <i>Banking and Financial Services</i>
• <i>Marketing</i>	• <i>Management</i>

Minimum entry requirements

4 year programme

- Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination with at least a mean grade of C+ with a minimum grade of C Plain in Mathematics and English or the equivalent; **OR**
- A Principal pass in the Kenya Advanced Certificate of Education Examination (A-Level) or GCE A-Level with a credit pass in Mathematics and English in the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (O-Level) or the equivalent; **OR**
- A one year diploma from a recognized institution with at least a mean grade of C (plain) and a grade C Plain in Mathematics and English in the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination or the equivalent.

3-Year Programme

- 2 year Diploma (from recognized institutions) or 2 principal passes in Kenya Advanced Certificate of education (A-Level) with at least a mean grade of C (plain) in the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination or its equivalent and a C plain or a credit pass in Mathematics and English.
- Advanced Diploma in ABE with at least a mean grade of C (plain) and a grade C (Plain) in Mathematics and English in the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination or the equivalent.

2-year programme

- Certified professional courses such as ACCA, CFA, CPS, CIPS, CPA, ACII, CIM, CIMA (Post graduate level) AKIB and holders of higher diplomas by Kenya National Examination Council or their equivalent.
- Higher/Advanced Diploma or first degree in related area with at least a mean grade of C (plain) in the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination or the equivalent.

DIPLOMAS

- **One year Advanced Diploma in Business Management (That leads to the two year B'COM degree programme)**

Minimum entry requirements

A two year ordinary Diploma in Business Management with at least a mean grade of C plain in KCSE or its equivalent.

- **Two year Ordinary Diploma in Business Management (That leads to the three year B'COM degree programme)**

Minimum entry requirements

A mean grade of C plain in the KCSE or the equivalent

Intensive University Access Programme

- **Bridging Course (Mathematics)**
Duration: One Semester

Admission Requirements

A mean grade of C+ at the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination or the equivalent and at least a D- in the subject(s) one is bridging.
