### **JUSTICE AND PEACE PROGRAMME 2009**

**MAY 15 – JUNE 26, 2010**

#### **Rationale**

Justice and Peace has been an urgent challenge facing Africa especially in the last years of the last century and also now. Most sectors are now involved in lobbying for peace at all levels.

To meet the demand for a united response to the need for justice and peace in our societies in Africa, the Catholic University of Eastern Africa offers a six weeks residential programme for agents of Justice and Peace drawn from all sectors. The programme is geared towards equipping the justice and peace partners from academia, civil society, policy practitioners and religious society with valuable knowledge and skills necessary in the peace process.

The six week programme consists of a module made up of six units. This intensive programme requires each participant to follow 6 hours per day, five days per week for six weeks.

This programme provides an opportunity for considerable individual attention both from the resource persons and from the peer group. Stress is placed on participant interaction and case study.

#### **Certificate**

Certificates will be awarded to those who complete a six week module comprising of six, two hour units - a total of 180 contact hours.

#### **Dates & Registration**

The sessions will begin with registration on Saturday 15th May 2010 at 10.00 a.m and close on Saturday 26th June 2010 at noon. The sessions will conclude with a time of assessment, evaluation and formal closure. Attendance at the opening and closing sessions is obligatory.

#### **Admission Requirements**

All candidates must have completed their secondary education. Candidates from other countries must have obtained an equivalent qualification. Copies of certificates should accompany the application

form. Students are expected to have a good knowledge of English, the language which is used for instruction.

### **Application Details**

Applications must be postmarked by March 31, 2010. A non-refundable application fee of Ksh.2,000/- must be submitted with the completed application form prior to the deadline.

### **Fees**

The fees for the six weeks residential program is Ksh. 106,000/-  
Accommodation is Ksh. 46,000/- and tuition fee is Ksh. 60,000/-.

### **Research Project Fees**

Diploma students are expected to pay a project fee of Ksh. 16,000/- payable on or before 15th January of their final Academic Year. They are also expected to submit **four copies** of their Research Projects to the Centre's office by the 15th June of the same year. The reports should be **hard cover bound and black in colour.**
