1. Bachelor of Education (Arts) with the following combinations: (Day, Weekend and School-Focused Programme)

- History/Christian Religious Education
- Geography/Christian Religious Education
- Geography/History
- English/Literature in English
- Kiswahili/History
- Kiswahili/Geography
- Kiswahili/Christian Religious Education
- Business Studies/Christian Religious Education
- Business Studies/History
- Business Studies/Geography
- Business studies/Kiswahili

2. Bachelor of Education (Science) with the following combination: (Day, Weekend and School-Focused Programme)

- Mathematics/Computer Science
- Business Studies/Computer Science

(NB: School-Focused programme for December Intake commences on Friday 4th December 2009)

3. Bachelor of Science in Computer Science (Day programme)

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

a) For Bachelor of Education (Arts and Science)

4 year programme

- Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination with at least a mean grade of C+ or the equivalent; **OR**
- A Principal pass in the Kenya Advanced Certificate of Education Examination (A-Level) or GCE A-Level or equivalent;
- **MUST** have a minimum of grade C plain or its equivalent in subjects related to the course applied for.

3-Year Programme

- P1 Teacher's Certificate or its equivalent; **OR**
- 2 principal passes in Kenya Advanced Certificate of education (A-Level) or equivalent.
- **MUST** have a minimum of grade C plain or its equivalent in subjects related to the course applied for.

2-year programme

- Diploma in Education or equivalent
- **MUST** have passed in subjects related to the course applied for.

b) For Bachelor of Education (Science) and Bachelor of Science in Computer Science

4 year programme

- Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination with at least a mean grade of C+ or the equivalent; **OR**

- A Principal pass in the Kenya Advanced Certificate of Education Examination (A-Level) or GCE A-Level or equivalent
- Must have a minimum grade of C plain in Mathematics at the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination or Applicants with Principal pass in Mathematics or Physics at the Kenya Advanced Certificate of Education Examination its equivalent.

3-Year Programme

Applicants with a diploma in Computer Science of the Kenya National Examinations Council or its equivalent.

2-Year Programme

Applicants with a higher diploma in Computer Science of the Kenya National Examinations Council or its equivalent.

4. BACHELOR OF COMMERCE with specialization in any of the following areas: (Day, Weekend and Evening Programme

• <i>Accounting</i>	• <i>Human Resources Management</i>
• <i>Finance</i>	• <i>Banking and Financial Services</i>
• <i>Marketing</i>	• <i>Management</i>

Minimum entry requirements

4 year programme

- Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination with at least a mean grade of C+ with a minimum grade of C Plain in Mathematics and English or the equivalent; **OR**
- A Principal pass in the Kenya Advanced Certificate of Education Examination (A-Level) or GCE A-Level with a credit pass in Mathematics and English in the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (O-Level) or the equivalent; **OR**
- A one year diploma from a recognized institution with at least a mean grade of C (plain) and a grade C Plain in Mathematics and English in the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination or the equivalent.

3-Year Programme

- 2 year Diploma (from recognized institutions) or 2 principal passes in Kenya Advanced Certificate of education (A-Level) with at least a mean grade of C (plain) in the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination or its equivalent and a C plain or a credit pass in Mathematics and English.
- Advanced Diploma in ABE with at least a mean grade of C (plain) and a grade C (Plain) in Mathematics and English in the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination or the equivalent.

2-year programme

- Certified professional courses such as ACCA, CFA, CPS, CIPS, CPA, ACII, CIM, CIMA (Post graduate level) AKIB and holders of higher diplomas by Kenya National Examination Council or their equivalent.
- Higher/Advanced Diploma or first degree in related area with at least a mean grade of C (plain) in the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination or the equivalent.

5. Intensive University Access Programmes (Day and Weekend)

- **Pre-University Access Programmes**

Duration: Two semesters

Admission Requirements:-

Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education with a mean Grade C Plain.

- **Bridging Courses (Mathematics and English)**

Duration: One Semester

Admission Requirements:-

A mean grade of C+ at the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination or the equivalent.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Application forms are available at the Admissions Office, The Catholic University of Eastern Africa, Langata Road, Nairobi or the Kisumu Campus office or downloaded from the website www.cuea.edu. Duly completed forms with copies of academic certificates, transcripts and other testimonials with a non-refundable application fee of **Ksh. 2000.00** for Degree and Pre-University Access programmes and **Ksh. 700.00** for Bridging Courses in a banker's cheque made payable to The Catholic University of Eastern Africa, or by cash deposit in the University's Bank Accounts should be **submitted to the Admissions Office at The Catholic University of Eastern Africa, Nairobi** or to the **Executive Director, Kisumu Campus not later than 4th December 2009 and 27th November 2009 for School-Focused December 2009 Intake**. The decision of the Admissions Committee is final.
