ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- a) Kenyan applicants,
- Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education with a minimum mean grade of C+ or,
 - Kenya Advanced Certificate of Education with a minimum of 2 principal passes or its equivalent.
 - Passed in subjects related to the course applied for.
 - Bachelor of Laws applicants must have a mean grade of B- with a minimum grade of B plain in English in the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination or its equivalent.
 - Bachelor of Commerce applicants must have a mean grade of C+ with a minimum grade of C plain in English and Mathematics.
 - Bachelor of Science in Computer Science applicants must have C plain in Mathematics.
 - Bachelor of Education (Business Studies & Economics) applicants must have C plain in Mathematics and English.
 - Bachelor of Education with a combination from the following: (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Computer Science, and Geography) applicants must have a grade C in the subjects at Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education or its equivalent or a principal pass in the subject(s) and a pass in any other Science subject at A-Level or a Credit in the subject(s) at Diploma level or its equivalent and a grade C in Mathematics.
- b) Non Kenyan applicants,
- Should satisfy the minimum university entry requirements of their country. They will also be required to have satisfied the requirements for specific departments in which they seek admission.
- NB:** For both Kenyan and Non-Kenyan students an adequate level of English Language proficiency is required.

COURSE DURATION

Holders of KCSE Certificate or its equivalent will join the four-year programme. Holders of KACE certificate or its equivalent will join the three-year programme.

Higher National Diploma/Diploma holders from institutions recognized by the CUEA Senate will join either a two-year/three-year programme. Holders of P1 Teacher's Certificate or its equivalent will join the three-year programme.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Duly completed forms with copies of academic certificates, transcripts and other testimonials with a non-refundable application fee of **Ksh. 2000.00** in a banker's cheque made payable to The Catholic University of Eastern Africa, or by cash deposit in the University's Bank Accounts should be **submitted to the Admissions Office not later than 17th April 2009**. The decision of the Admissions Committee is final.
