## **DAAD RESEARCH GRANTS FOR YOUNG KENYAN ACADEMICS 2020/2021**

In addition, **in collaboration with the Government of Kenya, DAAD will offer additional thirty (30) scholarships** to (permanent and part-time) staff of public and private universities and public research institutes to pursue a PhD in Germany.

**The scholarships are open to all fields of research. No age limit!**  
**The Master's degree must not be older than 6 years at the time of the application.**

Among the main requirements is a well-developed research proposal (10 to 15 pages). The applicant needs to have a supervisor in Germany or admission for a structured PhD programme.
